Procedures

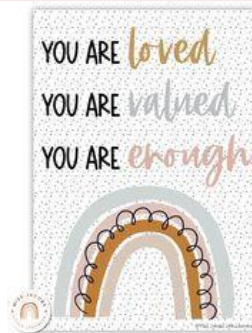
1. Beginning of the Day: Enter the classroom quietly and be ready to learn.

How To Get Involved?

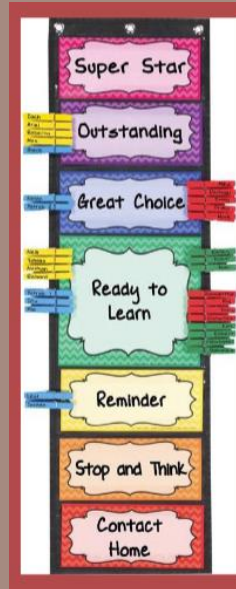
We would love to have you be apart of the classroom. Please contact Mrs. Messner or I if you see an area you would like to help out with.
